Jessica Beal-Stahl, PharmD, a pharmacist at Hobbs Pharmacy, will be educating us on benefits and usage of CBD. Hobbs was one of the pioneers in the county educating and selling CBD to customers. CBD, or cannabidiol, is the second most prevalent active ingredient in cannabis (marijuana). While CBD is an essential component of medical marijuana, it is derived directly from the hemp plant, a cousin of marijuana, or manufactured in a laboratory. CBD does not cause a "high" but does offer a variety of benefits proven in studies that are widely ranging from supporting your immune system, aiding in sleep and relaxation, or even helping with decreasing inflammation. Come learn more about the intriguing compound that is often misunderstood, as we cover the basics, how it works, dosing, choosing quality products and much more.

We invite cancer patients/survivors in any phase of treatment or recovery to attend. Caregivers are welcome as well.
